He Gives Strength to Me

And said, O man greatly beloved, fear not: peace be unto thee; be strong, yea be strong. And when he had spoken unto me, I was strengthened and said, Let my lord speak; for thou has strengthened me: (Daniel 10:19).

So many times we become weakened by our daily walk with God. Every day we are bombarded with situations that only God can fix—we try to fix them. Have we forgotten that we can have joy by praying in the Holy Ghost? The Bible says in Jude to “build up your most holy faith by praying in the Holy Ghost.”

“When we fail to plan; we plan to fail.” the saying goes. Isn’t it about time that we plan to pray? If I’ll stay in an attitude of prayer, We have to carve out time from our day to pray, on our commute, or between appointments. I wonder if that is effective praying. While I sometimes battle with the traffic, my itinerary, and other obligations, the greatest battle that I have to fight daily is the one with my own flesh. I can’t imagine trying to face my day without this time with God.

Even the roadblocks in our lives serve an important purpose in getting us where we need to be with the Lord. We often complain when we are stopped in our tracks from going in a direction that may be wrong for us. If we want to serve the Lord we must learn to trust the Lord and be slow to complain when the Lord stops us from making costly mistakes in our lives. Countless times I have been thankful that the Lord has kept me from acting on something that turned out to be wrong for me. Thank you, Lord, for ordering my steps in your will.

Worship makes a great difference in the atmosphere of the church. Think about it. When was the last time that you came into the church ready to lift your hands in praise and found that you were so eager just to get in the presence of the Lord that you couldn’t focus on anything else?

If people aren't praying and expecting a move of God—they may not feel God. I am blessed today, not because I deserve it, but because God is a merciful God; he never lets me forget that he loves me. When we come into the Lord’s presence with a humble spirit, the Lord entrusts us with his power and an anointing on our lives that will break every yoke.

Daniel 10, shows Daniel seeing a vision of himself with little strength. It could have discouraged him, but it didn’t end there. An angel of the Lord came and ministered to him, and he was immediately strengthened. If we want to have strength in our walk with God, we need to do three things on a daily basis: **PRAY, WORSHIP, and GIVE THANKS IN ALL THINGS.** There are many other things that are important, but these three are the keys to unlocking the power of God into your life. gm
