It's Time to Act on Our Faith

“Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

Not one of us would be here today without faith.

To reap good fruit, we must sow good seeds, and to allow the word to work for us we must act on the word and be in total obedience to the will of God. We could sometimes be identified as haphazard Christians: when everything is going our way, we don't have time to read the word and we enjoy the good life; when things fall apart in our lives, we turn to prayer and wonder why God allows things to happen to us while other Christians and the

world in general are succeeding. In all fairness, I must ask what makes me so different than the next person down the road? The Lord rains on the righteous and the unrighteous. He is no respecter of persons. He chose us to do his will and we need to take a good long look at life from God's perspective. We will see the mighty hand of God at work in our lives. Maybe not during the test designed to strengthen us, but after we have overcome the trial, and pause to reflect on the goodness and mercy of God. We shall see how God will arise and his enemies will be scattered. People may mean it for evil, but God is working all things out for our good. He cares about us for all eternity. –gm
