

It doesn’t matter that I’m not as popular, skilled, or talented as someone else: the fact remains that he has chosen me to fulfill his purpose for my life. When I am weak he is strong. He always causes me to triumph because he loves me and he sends his ministering angels to keep me protected from the enemy.

**He desires that I prosper and be in good health.** The Lord doesn’t cause sickness or heartache: SIN causes sickness and heartache. If we could cure the sin problem, there’d be no other problems. The Lord doesn’t cause death: SIN causes death. There will be no more dying when we have a glorified body.

**I must learn to be sensitive to God’s Spirit when he moves in me.** He will prepare me for the challenges I will face, because he knows that I need to be strengthened to sustain my spiritual walk. It may be a word from the Lord that urges me to, seek His face. The Word of God may seem to jump off of the page at me, at times: “My grace is sufficient for thee.” Or, it may simply be that He reminds me of His promise: “He that putteth his trust in me shall possess the land, and shall inherit my holy mountain” (Isaiah 57:13).

**He’s speaking to us, today; are we paying attention?** As the bible says in Ecclesiastes 12: 13-14, “Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil”
