

I'm learning that if I'll do what I can do, God sends an angel to carry me through what I can't do. If we do not start walking towards our goals, we will never reach them.

**It's more important to build a strong foundation for one dream,** than it is to have many dreams without a foundation. Taking the time to grow the seeds that we plant, will produce more fruit than abandoning the vulnerable seeds before they are established.

**Church, we need each other.** If I'm weak in certain areas of ministry, you may be strong in those areas. I may be strong in areas of ministry where you may need help. There may be times when you need to have someone to lean on. We edify each other; we lift each other up. By helping each other, we are lifting up the body of Christ. Foundations—the church is built on a solid foundation—the rock.

**Why do you suppose the Lord chose Peter to establish the first church?** He had experience in dealing with failure, maybe? After all, Peter denied Christ three times. He messed up. Did Jesus, who was to be crucified, turn around and “crucify” Peter for his mistakes? No, Jesus forgave him after Peter had wept bitterly in repentance, and then recognized that the church that he wanted to establish had to be built on a solid foundation. As a body, we work together, and we complement each other; as a church, we work in unity to build a strong foundation.

**Keep on dreaming your dreams; it will take prayer to hold it all together** when the storms come, but if we'll stay in the Word, and lift each other up; we can build a foundation that'll stand united no matter what storms may come our way.
