It's Time to Celebrate Mothers

We celebrate life today, the lives of women who have given of themselves unconditionally to their families. It takes more than having a child to be a mother. Every woman of God is someone's mother. Dear Mom,

Listen closely to the wind from the wings of angels that I prayed God would send. They'll keep you and protect you each and every day. They'll provide shelter from the storms that you may have to face.

When trials settle in your life, I'm believing that you'll trust in God to always be a prayer away. I prayed that the Lord would always keep you through even the darkest nights. And although it seems that we've grown so far apart, I want you to know that for every mile that separates us, I've kept you two miles closer in my heart.

I love you more than I sometimes show, and I'm so thankful that we're so close in spirit. I can't fully explain the love that I feel for you; saying it seems inadequate too, so I'll simply say: Hugs to you, Mom. I love you, your number 2 daughter.

Thoughts to ponder: What If...?

What if God couldn't take time to bless us today, because we didn't take time to thank Him yesterday?

What if God decided to stop leading us tomorrow, because we didn't follow Him today?

What if we never saw another flower bloom, because we grumbled when God sent the rain?

What if God didn't walk with us, today, because we failed to recognize it as His day?

What if God took away the Bible, tomorrow, because we would not read it today?

What if God took away his message, because we failed to listen to his messenger?

What if the door of the Church was closed, because we didn't open the door to our heart?

What if God stopped loving and caring for us, because we failed to love and care for others?

What if God wouldn't hear us, today, because we wouldn't listen to Him yesterday?

What if God answered our prayers the way we answer His call for service?

What if God met our needs according to the way we give to Him of our substance?
