The Secret to Success is not a Secret

What is the secret to success? The Secret is revealed when we search the scriptures. It seems that some people are born to be successful, while others struggle just to survive their day.

We know that some people in the world who don't know Christ appear, at times, to have every aspect of their lives well-controlled. They may have nice clothes, drive only the best vehicles and have money in the bank. When you evaluate their lives by the world's measure, it looks as though they have everything going for them.

Spiritually, however, another story is revealed: it's a story of poverty, destitution, and loneliness. Outside of Jesus Christ we can't survive in this world. We need a Savior. Of the few truly wealthy people that I have met (those who were not living for God), one hundred percent have said that they weren't happy with their lives. They felt that something essential was missing from their lives, and they were continually trying this and that to find the missing peace of mind that only comes by way of the cross. These people tried to depend on their wealth to provide a lifestyle that left out God.

To be in this state of poverty in spiritual matters has a profound effect on the people around you and on your outlook on life. Further, continued lack of motivation will eventually affect our physical well-being. The riches of this world pales in comparison to the riches of God's glory in our lives, and there is only one way to keep from finding yourself in that state of despair: that is through Jesus Christ.

In Joshua 1, the secret of success is revealed once and for all: "Be strong and of good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land which I swear unto their fathers to give them. Only be thou strong and very courageous that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest."

Sometimes you may need to encourage yourself if there is no one who will take the time to listen. When life is a challenge and it seems that no matter what you do, the situations that you find yourself in become perpetual; then, it's time to step back and look at your situation from the Lord's viewpoint. If you are living for the Lord, you will be tested; however, when you are tested, the way to have success is by doing the will of God even when the situation seems hopeless. You may not think that there is a way to find that peace of mind talked about in scripture, but today, in Joshua 1:9, the way to find it is revealed. The steps that you take, now, will determine your entire future:

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night; that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein; for then, thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

So, the secret to success is not a secret. Get in the word; take hold of your promise, and live for God as he unfolds the plans for your life. May the Lord richly bless you as you seek him and find him. gm
