## Are You Willing to Humble Yourself?

I could talk about Naboth, who through his steadfastness was able to hold on to his inheritance even in the midst of great danger if he refused to comply; but, what strikes me about the passage of scripture in I Samuel 21 is that when Elijah told Ahab that he was going to face judgment for his part in Naboth's death: he could have denied it; or blamed everything on Jezebel; instead, he took responsibility for his actions, rent his garments, put on sackcloth and ashes, and humbled himself before God. It was enough to get God's attention and delay judgment from his household for a few more years.

We are living in a time when people have forgotten the awesome power that is released when we humble ourselves before God. Where there is a time to stand fast, there is also a time to humble ourselves. When we reach a place in God that we are obedient and open to his will in our lives, then, we are in a place that we can be used by the Lord for his glory. It is in our nature to rise up, and be stubborn and unmoving; but, it takes a broken vessel, vulnerable, and yielded to his will, to touch the Lord in a new dimension of worship and praise.

Throughout this year of prayer we have been exercising our privilege to call on the name of Jesus. It is indeed a privilege to speak that name. There is power in that name and we shouldn't use it lightly. The Lord promises us that “If my people which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then, will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. Now mine eyes shall be open, and mine ears attent unto the prayer that is made in his place. For now have I chosen and sanctified this house, that my name may be there for ever: and mine eyes and mine heart shall be there perpetually” (2 Chronicles 7:14-16).

“Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word or our epistle” (II Thessalonians 2:15). Today, we have all been fortunate enough to have an inheritance given to us if we have been baptized in Jesus Name and have been filled with the Holy Ghost. When we are adopted into the family of God we become heirs to a rich inheritance. Unfortunately, many people today never fully comprehend the value of their heritage, so they reject the blessings of the Lord and trade them for the pleasures of sin. Our inheritance is not for sale, when we obey the word of Jesus Christ, we can possess eternal life.

Do you want to receive what the Lord has promised?

Stand fast, and hold the traditions. “And so after he patiently endured, he obtained the promise” (Hebrews 6:15). *gm*
