

Too often we take matters into our own hands, and as a result of our impatience, we struggle needlessly because we didn’t allow the Lord to lead us through the treacherous maze of events unfolding in our lives.

Today, in our instant everything society, we become uncomfortable waiting for the good seeds that we have planted to grow: so what do we do? We go get the shovel and dig them up, only to replant them in a “better” location. After a time, we over tend our precious seeds, practically drowning them with our care and attention, forcing them to sprout before they are strong enough to stand on their own. When the storms come they may bend with the wind, or break under the pressures of life. Because there is no strong root system, they are vulnerable to every adversity. If only we had taken the time to allow our precious seed to take root, rest in the Lord, and learn. For saints who are established in the Truth: it didn’t happen overnight. Growth takes time. It’s the one thing that we are all given equally: 24 hours to work with every day.

I have a choice to make: spend it wisely, or lose it foolishly by worrying about the things that I should be placing in God’s hands. He is timeless, and my situation and prayer will be answered at the perfect time, so that all things that I have prayed about will work together for my good. I don’t want to keep delaying the fulfillment of God’s promise in my life by getting the shovel of doubt and digging out the beginnings of my miraculous provision. Only God can deliver the answer to prayer, and when I continue to dig in doubt, instead of speaking life, the precious seeds that should produce fruit, will appear lifeless; if they appear at all, because I was too impatient to give them the necessary time to get established. Teach me, Lord, to wait in your presence. Thank you for your promise. *gm*

Random Thoughts...




Six-year-old Angie and her four-year-old brother Joel were sitting together during church services. Joel giggled, sang, and talked out loud. Finally, his big sister had enough.
