Restore unto me thy Will

“Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.” (John 4:34)

Let’s get honest here. If you’re trying to drive somewhere, there usually is that one person who can get you there, no problem. There is probably that one person who can’t get you there! You might use Mr. Garmin or Mr. Google to get you there, but even they aren’t always accurate as Grace and I found out driving in the mountains one time, having been led to the top of a mountain only to see our cabin on ANOTHER mountain.

Similarly, in our journey through life, we often need direction. It may be where to work, who to marry, what to do for the Lord, how to talk to someone who is troubled. Or it could be, “Lord, what is your will for me to do in your kingdom?” I want God’s direction for my life. I don’t want to try to do this on my own. Even Jesus asked for the Father’s direction: *“For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me. And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.” (John 6:38, 40)*

God has some “universal” wills for us which He makes mention to in His Word. Living a holy life, worshiping and praising, praying, and sharing the Gospel are just some: *“I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect will of God.” (Romans 12:1-2). “Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.” (I Thes. 5:16-18) “And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.” (Mark 16:15)*

But what about things in my life that I need direction on? What is God’s will for my life? I **want** to do the will of God in my life; I count it a **joy!** I’m as David when he said *“I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law is within my heart.” (Psalm 40:8) “Show me thy ways, O Lord; teach me thy paths.” (Psalm 25:4)* Prayer is my first resource and makes sense (seek God...God’s will). Solomon indeed had wisdom when he said, *“Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.” (Proverbs 3:5-6)* Another resource is getting into the word of God. *“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.” (Psalm 119:105)*

My prayer for you this week is that you will take some time to seek God, asking Him for direction and to help accomplish His will for your life. Seek and you shall find./wm
