John 3:16—An Easter Story of Love, Faith, and Hope

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son...”

God’s love is not like our emotional love; God love is unconditional. Love is the main aspect of God’s character. In Jesus, God became man, dwelt among us, and gave his only Son to die for our sins and be resurrected. “Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.” (I John 4:10) Jesus, the perfect sacrifice for our sins, committed Himself to the cross, knowing He was to be crucified. He said in John 15:13, “Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.” Jesus knew his crucifixion was going to be horrible, but not my will but thy will be done. Jesus did all this for you. Let me repeat myself: Jesus did it all for you, friend. That’s love!

“...that whosoever believeth in him...” Faith in Jesus. I believe He is the promised Messiah, born of the virgin Mary, and knew no sin. I believe He walked on this earth just as we do. I believed He performed many miracles. I believe He died on the cross, rose victoriously from the grave in three days, and is seated at the right hand of God. I believe God sends the Holy Ghost to those who seek it. “And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever.” “But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name...” (John 14:16,26) I believe the same spirit that abided in Christ lives within me: “But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.” (Romans 8:11) That’s faith!

“...should not perish, but have everlasting life.” Hope. I believe Jesus died on the cross, but I believe He arose from the grave and lives forever! And this gives me a blessed hope. Sin caused a great separation from God and us; Jesus, the sacrificial Lamb of God, bridged that gap. We can have eternal life with Jesus in heaven! He has defeated death and the grave. “For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.” (I Thess. 4:16-17) Eternity with Jesus in Heaven: “In my Father’s house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again...” (John 14:2-3) In a world of uncertainty, I can be certain I will be living in the presence of God with no more death, no more pain, and no more troubles!
