Move From Fear to Prayer and Praise!

“The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell. Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident. One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in his temple.” (Psalm 27:1-4)

From an early age, David faced some situations where he probably felt afraid. We know the story of his battle with Goliath, but as a shepherd, David had to defend his flocks of sheep from bears, lions, wolves...countless dangers this teenager had to fight (and destroy) to protect his sheep. Before he became King, David lived as a fugitive on the run constantly from King Saul who, because of jealousy probably, wanted to kill David who hid in caves and outran (and outsmarted) the army of Saul. This was surely a fearful time in David's life!

So how did David survive this test of faith in his life? Psalm 27 (written by David) gives us insight into how he got through these tough times. He calls the Lord “the strength of my life; whom shall I be afraid?” David trusted God to protect him. And God did! “When the wicked, even my enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.” (vs. 2) Psalm 27 also tells us where David went when he was in trouble: he went to the house of the Lord to worship and pray. The results: David felt hidden, safe, and protected: “He shall set me up upon a rock.” When fear attacked David, he sought after God in prayer: “Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the

Lord.” (Psalm 27:14) Prayer defeated fear!

Prayer and praise will always conquer fear. David, in Psalm 55, vs. 16-18, 22: “As for me, I will call upon God; and the Lord shall save me. Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice. He hath delivered my soul in peace from the battle that was against me: for there were many with me. Cast thy burden upon the Lord, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.” The Lord my strength: “Blessed be the Lord, because he hath heard the voice of my supplications. The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise Him.” (Psalm 28:6-7) “In God will I praise his word: in the Lord will I praise his word. In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me.” (Psalm 56:10-11) “But I will sing of thy power; yea, I will sing aloud of thy mercy in the morning: for thou hast been my defense and refuge in the day of my trouble.” (Psalm 59:16)

So let us not stay troubled or in fear. We have the keys to victory: prayer and praise! And our God is ready to help us as seek Him in prayer (spiritual battles) and praise (spiritual victories)! -wm
