Putting God First in our Lives

“Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord: And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.”

(Deuteronomy 6:4-5)

“Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment.”

(Matthew 22:37-38)

God did many miracles for the enslaved Israelites. The plagues He sent. Freedom from Egyptian bondage. The parting of the Red Sea. Fresh manna every morning. The promise of a new land they could call home. The promise that He would take care of His people. And in return? God wanted His people to worship Him and put Him first in their lives. When the Israelites would make camp during their wandering in the desert, God specifically told them how to arrange the camp. Certain tribes were placed in the north, south, east, and west, and in the middle of all the tribes, right in the center of the camp, was the tabernacle where they would worship God. God wanted to be in the center of their lives.

Our God is a jealous God: “For thou shalt worship no other god: for the Lord, whose name is jealous, is a jealous God:” (Exodus 34:14) “For the Lord thy God is a consuming fire, even a jealous God.” (Deuteronomy 4:24) God wants to be first in our lives. That doesn't mean we can't “want” or “love” other things in our lives. It means He doesn't want these “other things” to put God in second place (or third, or fourth, etc.) If “other things” (status, material possessions, money, people, sin, free time, etc.) turn into idols in our lives and we start putting them instead of the Lord, we have broken God's covenant with us: “But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.” (Matthew 6:33) Anything we love more than God is an idol. Where do you primarily spend your time? Your money? Your emotions? Is God *truly* first in you *and* your family?

Sometimes we can become so involved in working our ministry, that it becomes our focus instead of God's will; thus it may even become a hindrance to us. God must be in the center of all that we are and all that we do, even in church. If we forget to support our ministry in prayer, and we replace our worship with our ministry, both will suffer from neglect. Our disorganized priorities block our view of the incredible world that we live in. When ministry blocks our view to the glory of God, we need to step aside and allow God to have His rightful place in our lives.

Jesus gave His life as the ultimate sacrifice for us to have eternity with Him. Keep Jesus first in your life and watch Him perform miracles in your life! -wm


