-Educator's Sunday/Back to School Rally... Sunday morning/ Sunday night on August 28th! Damon Peavy Jr. will be ministering!

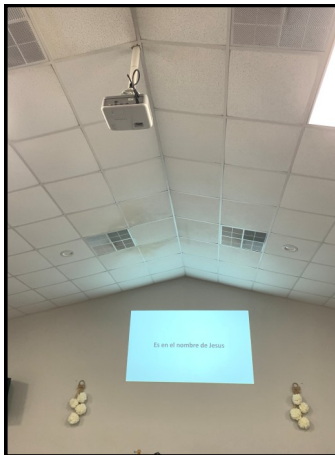
