The Center of the Bible

"It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in princes." (Psalm 118:8)

The book of Psalms happens to be my favorite book in God's word. We read in this book about David, and we see how he handled problems in life. We read about worship, and we see how they worshipped God then and how we have incorporated these acts of worship into the Apostolic church of today. We read about repentance, and we see how David came to God with a heart that sought forgiveness and desired change. And yet, there is a peculiarity about this book!

What is the shortest chapter in the Bible? Answer: Psalm 117

What is the longest chapter in the Bible? Answer: Psalm 119

What chapter is in the center of the Bible? Answer: Psalm 118

There are 594 chapters before Psalm 118.

There are 594 chapters after Psalm 118.

Add up 594 plus 594, and you get 1188.

What is the center verse in the Bible? Answer: Psalm 118:8!

Does this chapter and verse say something significant about God's perfect will for our lives? This central chapter in God's word points to Jesus. David is giving us direction on how to live our lives with joy and hope that Jesus alone can give us. The next time someone says that they would like to find God's will for their lives and want to be in the center of His will, just send them to the center of His Word!

- This chapter begins with giving thanks and then tells us to keep on praising and worshiping God even when it seems that the enemy has the upper hand... "O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: because his mercy endureth forever." (vs. 1) "I called upon the Lord in distress: the Lord answered me, and set me in a large place. The Lord is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?" (vs. 5-6)
- We are to go to God in prayer... "I called upon the Lord in distress" (vs. 5)
- We are to go and worship God in the sanctuary... "Open to me the gates of righteousness: I will go into them, and I will praise the Lord." (vs. 19)
- God hears our prayers... "I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me..." (vs. 21)
- We read a prophetic statement (see Eph. 2:20) that Jesus is the chief cornerstone of the church... "The stone which the builders refused is become the head stone of the corner." (vs. 22)
- Also we see prophetic words (see Mark 11:9) describing Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem... "Blessed be he that cometh in the name of the Lord" (vs. 26)
- Jesus also quoted vs. 24 in Luke 20:17... "His mercy endureth forever"... mentioned 5 times in this chapter! (vs. 1,2,3,4, and 29)

Why not let Jesus be the center of your life, today? Thank you for visiting us this morning! -wm
